FEMA Disaster Recovery Center open in Friendswood

Monday through Saturday from 9:00am to 7:00pm and Sundays from noon to 5:00pm.

Representatives from FEMA and from other agencies, including the Small Business Administration (SBA), State organizations, volunteer groups and others will be at the Center to answer questions about disaster assistance and low-interest disaster loans for homeowners, renters and businesses.
